

Theory of Change

We partner with public health facilities in remote areas. This is where majority of underserved mothers and newborns receive care from, to address barriers that cause delay in seeking, reaching and receiving care through Proactive Doorstep Care, an affordable and scalable solution.

Interventions

Engage - Mobilize communities and increase ownership and participation of community leaders and groups in monitoring maternal and child services and behaviors

Strengthen - Form functional referral systems to connect communities to health facilities to improve emergency care.

Build - Equip primary health care providers with skills and resources to provide quality maternal and child health care at the doorstep.
